Welcome!

Before beginning a new ATHLETE registration, please have on hand:

- Recent headshot from shoulders up.
- Government-issued proof-of-age: birth certificate, drivers license, passport or state-issued ID.

NOTE: If you're athlete is at least 18 or will turn 18 by May 31 of the current membership term, a background check and abuse prevention training are required. You will be guided during the registration process if this is a requirement for your athlete.

- 5. Choose to create a COACH account.
- 6. Familiarize yourself with and accept the membership agreement.
- 7. Complete OPTIONAL heritage survey.
- 8. Enter COACH profile info.
- 9. Upload headshot.
- 10. Check CHEER, DANCE or both as appropriate.
- 11. Confirm, add or change CLUB and location affiliation.
- 12. Make payment (\$75).
- 13. Follow the prompts to initiate background screening (no added cost).
- 14. Complete abuse training (no added cost).

NOTE: You must be affiliated with a CLUB with at least four active member athletes to access credentialing and legality review resources.

XSF Membership Club Registration

Welcome!

Before beginning the CLUB registration or renewal process, please have on hand proof of general liability insurance.

NEW CLUB MEMBERS: As you create a CLUB account, a COACH/OWNER account will be created automatically for you. After completing the CLUB account requirements, log in to your COACH/OWNER account, pay and complete the requirements for eligible COACH membership.

IMPORTANT: If you have an existing COACH account, do not create a new CLUB account. Contact abruno@usasf.net so that your existing COACH account may be merged with a new CLUB account.

Log in

- 2. Click JOIN NOW / RENEW.

- 1. Enter your email at CREATE AN ACCOUNT TODAY!

NOTE: During this process, you will be required to upload proof of general liability insurance.

Eligible club status

Once all owners of all CLUB locations become eligible COACH members, complete the OWNERSHIP MANAGEMENT task:

- 1. Click MY PROFILE > OWNERS.
- 2. ADD/REMOVE owners as needed > SAVE.
- 3. Click MY PROFILE > LOCATION.
- 4. Click applicable location name > OWNERSHIP MANAGEMENT.
- 5. Assign an ownership percentage to each name to total 100% > SAVE.
- 6. After completing all steps above, your CLUB will become eligible.

Take action on terms & conditions

CONCILIONS

- 1. Complete the Owners Hiring & Screening Training.
- 2. Require all adult employees, athletes and volunteers to complete abuse prevention education.
- 3. Offer abuse prevention education for minor athletes on an annual basis.
- 4. Provide mandatory reporter training for all adult employees and volunteers.
- 5. Provide a concussion policy and training for all coaches.
- 6. Share the concussion policy with athlete parents/ guardians
